

Attendance Incentives and Rewards

At Rushy Meadow Primary Academy we recognise good attendance.

We have a cycle of rewards and incentives as listed below.

Frequency	Action/Incentive
Daily	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Registers are completed and absences logged
Weekly	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ The best attending classes are named in a whole school assembly.○ Attendance trophies are given to the classes with the first, second and third best attendance over the week.○ Children who attended school every day over the week get a raffle ticket for the termly raffle.
Termly	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Children's names go into the raffle (KS1/EYFS, Lower KS2 and Upper KS2). Prizes may include toys, games, colouring or craft equipment, or an invitation to a special afternoon tea. Several names are drawn out from each phase.○ A whole school celebration assembly takes place.○ Certificates are given to the best attending classes, and to individual children who have 100% attendance.○ The best attending class receive individual attendance badges.
Yearly	<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Certificates and stickers are given to individual children who have 100% attendance over the whole year.○ A grand end of year prize draw takes place for children who have attended more than 97% of the time. The prizes this year (2017/18) are a scooter for EYFS/KS1, a scooter for Lower KS2 and a bike for Upper KS2.

We also regularly publish good attendance on our school blogs, and have a display board near the main school entrance, which shows current whole school attendance, and our school attendance target.
